



## **Management of the 2019 COVID - 19 Outbreak Situation – Precautionary Measures at the Hindu Centre**

Namaste all

As the status of the outbreak of the COVID- 19 disease has been raised to Orange since last 7<sup>th</sup> Feb 2020 in Singapore, **it is mandatory for all visitors of the Hindu Centre to follow these 3 protocols:**

1. Indicate your contact information so as to facilitate quick contact tracing;
2. Take your body temperature when you come into Hindu Centre for any event, meeting, classes, etc;
3. Make your travel declaration for all overseas trips made since 14 January 2020.

**IN THE EVENT THAT YOUR TEMPERATURE IS HIGHER THAN 37.5C, OR YOU HAVE TRAVELLED TO ANY PART OF CHINA (INCL HONGKONG and MACAU), YOU SHOULD NOT VISIT HINDU CENTRE. FURTHERMORE, YOU ARE ADVISED TO WEAR A MASK AND PROCEED TO THE NEAREST HOSPITAL.**

### **1. Sharing of contact information**

Please provide your personal contact information which will be necessary to facilitate quick contact tracing if required. Should a confirmed case have interacted with you, you can be immediately notified so that the necessary action can be taken to prevent further transmission of the virus.

Please note that your personal information will be kept in strictest confidence and will be used only for official purposes, as governed under the Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA).

### **2. Temperature recording**

Starting from today, 14 February 2020, all visitors to the Hindu Centre are required to take their temperature when they enter the premises. We will have a thermometer provided at the Centre. If you have fever or symptoms such as a cough or flu, please see a doctor immediately and do not come to the Hindu Centre.

### **3. Compulsory declaration of overseas trips**

It is essential for all visitors to submit their travel declarations to the Centre. Forms are provided at the entrance.

The Hindu Centre continues to monitor the COVID -19 situation closely and will provide further updates, including adopting further precautionary measures as and when needed. We seek all your cooperation to take all the precautionary measures seriously. Please help the Hindu Centre in doing our part to stop the spread of the virus.
